Mayor Claudia Anderson called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m.

**Pre-Canvass of the “Bluffdale City Citizen’s Referendum Election” – Final Count of Provisional Ballots.**


City Recorder, Teddie Bell, reported that the purpose of the meeting was to report on the final tally for the Bluffdale City Referendum Election provisional ballots. Ten valid provisional ballots were submitted. There were six votes in favor and four votes against. The final count was 424 votes in favor and 416 votes against. It was determined that the referendum passed.

Mrs. Bell reported that this was a pre-canvass and that an official canvass needed to be conducted announcing the totals and declaring the STP zone passed. She stated that the canvass could be done not sooner than seven days nor more than 14 days. The Mayor wanted to do it as soon as possible. The canvass was scheduled for Wednesday, July 5 at 6:00 p.m.

Mrs. Bell clarified that the canvass must take place after which time individuals could ask for a recount.
