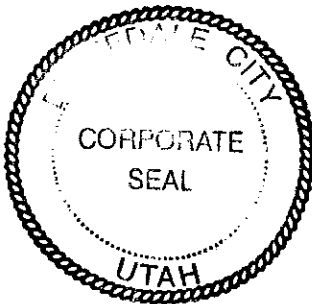

ORDINANCE NO.2006-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT FOR BLUFFDALE CITY, APPOINTING A CITY MANAGER AND REPEALING BLUFFDALE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2002-19

WHEREAS, in 2002, the Bluffdale City Council repealed Ordinance 6-13-95 establishing a manager form of government.

WHEREAS, the Bluffdale City Council has determined the need to establish a manager form of government and appoint a person to act as City Manager; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated section §10-3-830 authorizes the governing body to establish a manager form of government by ordinance and appoint a manager to serve at the pleasure of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to appoint the current Administrative Services Director to serve as the City Manager; and,

WHEREAS, by repealing Ordinance 2002-19 would eliminate the position of City Recorder, the City Council desires to reestablish the office of City Recorder;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BLUFFDALE CITY COUNCIL, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal. Bluffdale City Ordinance 2002-19 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Adoption of Form of Government. By repeal of Ordinance 2002-19, the Bluffdale City Council hereby adopts a City Manager by ordinance form of government pursuant to *Utah Code Ann.* 10-3-830.

Section 3. Appointment of City Manager. The current Administrative Services Director is hereby appointed as the City Manager. Should the City Manager's position become vacant in the future, the City Council may appoint another qualified individual to fill the vacancy without amending this section of the ordinance.

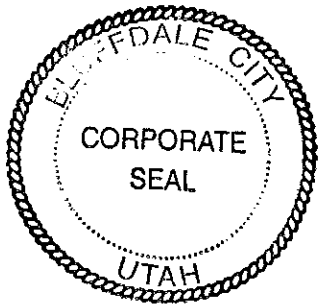
Section 4. Duties of the City Manager. The City Manager is hereby appointed as the chief executive officer of the City. Except as otherwise delegated by the City Council, all administrative powers, authority and duties of the City are hereby vested in the City Manager. Various administrative powers and duties of the City Manager may be delegated by the City Manager and/or the City Council to other City officers and employees. The following duties of the Mayor may not be delegated to the City Manager, other City officers, or employees: the Mayor's legislative or judicial powers; the Mayor's position as chairman of the governing body; or any *ex officio* positions the Mayor holds.

Section 5. Severability. If any part or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all provisions, clauses and words of this Ordinance shall be severable. This Section shall become effective without codification.


Section 6. City Recorder. The municipal office of City Recorder is hereby established for Bluffdale City. The current City Recorder is hereby appointed to continue in her capacity as City Recorder and perform all of the duties prescribed by Utah law, City ordinance, policy or resolution for the office of City Recorder.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication or posting, or thirty (30) days after passage, whichever occurs first.


