

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BLUFFDALE CITY WATER DEPARTMENT TO REDUCE CUSTOMER CHARGES

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Bluffdale City to reduce water bills when there is an undetected water leak in Bluffdale citizen's water line for a period of six (6) months or longer.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Bluffdale City Council as follows:

Section 1. Qualification Requirements. The City Administrator is authorized to reduce a citizen's water charges where the Water Department determines there has been an undetectable leak in the citizen's water line for more than six (6) months.

Section 2. Reduction Calculation. The Water Department shall calculate the reduction of a qualifying citizen's water charges by billing the retail price of water of water for the number of gallons used for the same period the previous year and charging the wholesale price for the balance of the water used.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

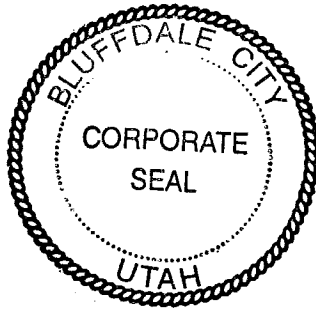
