PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS,** In 1872 J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for the planting of trees, and

**WHEREAS,** this holiday called Arbor Day was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska, and

**WHEREAS,** Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world; and

**WHEREAS,** Bluffdale City desires to promote the importance of trees for the benefits they provide for its citizens; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS MAYOR OF BLUFFDALE CITY, I HEREBY PROCLAIM APRIL 29th, 2005 AS ARBOR DAY IN BLUFFDALE UTAH AND ENCOURAGE ALL RESIDENTS AND VISITORS TO BECOME ACTIVE IN THE PROMTING AND PRESERVATION OF TREES.**
