

**BLUFFDALE CITY UTAH
RESOLUTION NO. 2006-08**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE INTENT OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF
BLUFFDALE CITY TO ENSURE CONTINUATION OF MASS TRANSIT (BUS)
SERVICE BY UTA TO THE CITY.**

WHEREAS, the Bluffdale City Council recognizes and acknowledges their responsibility to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Bluffdale City; and

WHEREAS, Bluffdale City will be best served by continuing and/or expanding mass transit service to and from the City; and

WHEREAS, the discontinuation of any mass transit service would result in hardship on citizens who rely on such service; and

WHEREAS, the southwest quadrant of Salt Lake County, of which Bluffdale City is a part, is the fastest growing area in Salt Lake County; and

WHEREAS, the citizens in the southwest quadrant of Salt Lake County pay proportionally similar taxes to those taxes paid by citizens from other parts of the County where the level of mass transit service far exceeds the level of service in the southwest quadrant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BLUFFDALE CITY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Intent. That the intent of the Bluffdale City Council is that Bluffdale City continue to receive mass transit service at the current and/or an increased level.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, part or provision of this Resolution is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Resolution and all sections, parts and provisions of this Resolution shall be severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute and cause to be delivered the same.
