**A RESOLUTION OF THE BLUFFDALE CITY COUNCIL DECLAIRING
CERTAIN FIRE DEPARTMENT ASSETS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE
SALE OF SAID ASSETS TO THE HIGHEST BIDDER.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bluffdale City recognizes that certain city assets have reached their useful life and are no longer beneficial to the city or its departments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bluffdale City recognizes that said assets may still hold monetary value for the city and its departments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bluffdale City desires to capture any monetary value through the sale of said assets for the benefit of the city and its departments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
BLUFFDALE CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Sale of Property. The Bluffdale City Council declares the property listed in Exhibit A as surplus and to be sold to the highest bidder.

Section 2. Purchase Price. The sale of said property is to be sold to the highest bidder for cash. The city council recognizes that other governmental and quasi-governmental organizations may benefit from the purchase of these assets. If the assets are sold to said organizations, the city may sell said assets through an informal bid process.

Section 3. Authorization to Sell. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to sell the assets listed in Exhibit A and collect all monetary value of said property.


Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
