

RESOLUTION 2007-03

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILL OF THE CITY COUNCIL THAT MARTHA SPEED SHOULD SERVE AS MAYOR PRO TEMPORE DURING 2007

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated §10-3-403 provides that the mayor shall be the chairman and preside at the meetings of the governing body;

WHEREAS, Section 10-3-403 provides that in the absence of the mayor or because of her inability or refusal to act, the city council may elect one of its members to preside over the meeting as mayor pro tempore, who shall have all of the powers and duties of the mayor during her absence or disability;

WHEREAS, Section 10-3-403 also provides that the election of a mayor pro tempore shall be entered in the minutes of the meeting where he or she is elected;

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated § 10-3-705 provides that ordinances passed or enacted by the city council shall be signed by the mayor, or if she is absent, by the mayor pro tempore, or by a quorum of the governing body, and shall be recorded before taking effect; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City for the Council to express its will in advance that Martha Speed should act as mayor pro tempore in the Mayor's absence until January 22, 2008;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of Bluffdale City, Utah that the Council:

- Hereby expresses its will and consent that Martha Speed should serve as mayor pro tempore in the Mayor's absence until January 22, 2008; and
2. Expresses its understanding that absent a change of circumstances or her absence, Martha Speed will be nominated to serve as mayor pro tempore until January 22, 2008 wherein the mayor is absent and that such vote shall be entered in the minutes of such meeting; and
3. Expresses its understanding that the mayor pro tempore shall have all of the powers and duties of the mayor during her absence or disability, and shall sign any ordinances passed or elected in the mayor's absence.
4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
