RESOLUTION NO. 2007-04

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE PROPOSED MERGER BETWEEN U.S. AIRWAYS AND DELTA AIRLINES.

WHEREAS, Delta Air Lines, Inc., (“Delta”) became an air passenger airline in 1928 and inaugurated service to four (4) cities in 1929; and

WHEREAS, Delta currently provides thousands of jobs to residents of the Salt Lake Valley and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, Delta’s safe and reliable air transportation, distinctive customer service, and hospitality from the heart is important to the citizens of Bluffdale City; and

WHEREAS, Delta’s vision is to build on its traditions and always meet customer expectations, while taking service to even higher levels of excellence; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2005 Delta took a necessary and responsible step to secure its future by voluntarily filing to reorganize under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code; and

WHEREAS, Delta and its employees have worked hard to regain an industry position of strength and leadership; and

WHEREAS, Delta is on track to exit bankruptcy in 2007 as an independent, stand-alone company; therefore

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR OF BLUFFDALE CITY, STATE OF UTAH AS FOLLOWS; Believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Bluffdale City and the employees and customers of Delta Airlines, Inc., as well as the economic welfare of the entire region, for Delta to be given the opportunity to emerge from bankruptcy as a stand-alone, independent company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Bluffdale City supports Delta’s plan to recover from Chapter 11 bankruptcy as an independent, stand-alone entity.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that Bluffdale City stands in opposition to any unsolicited offer or any merger attempt from any entity that may diminish Delta’s importance as an employer and corporate citizen on this region.
