RESOLUTION No. 2007-70

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

Whereas, the City Council desires to express its approval for the disposal of certain items of outdated, obsolete and/or surplus property,

Now, therefore, the City Council of Bluffdale, Utah, resolves:

Section 1. The following items of personal property have been identified to be surplus, obsolete or outmoded, and may be disposed of: miscellaneous obsolete computer equipment, washing machine and clothes dryer, old sinks, old fax machine, Olympia typewriter, telephone system, old couch, old water meters, old street sign. The City Manager is authorized and directed to dispose of such item or items, as provided herein. Items may be sold at public auction to the highest bidder. Items which may have value to a governmental or quasi-governmental organization may be sold at a mutually-agreed price, without the necessity of the public auction.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective immediately.

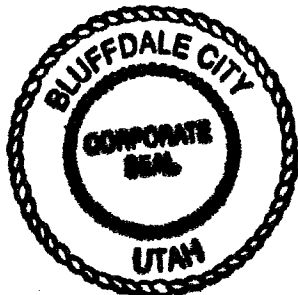
