A RESOLUTION OF THE BLUFFDALE CITY COUNCIL

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED THAT:

WHEREAS, the County operates a Jail, known as the Adult Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, the Adult Detention Center operates beyond its operational capacity, requiring individuals which would otherwise be incarcerated to be released back into the community; and

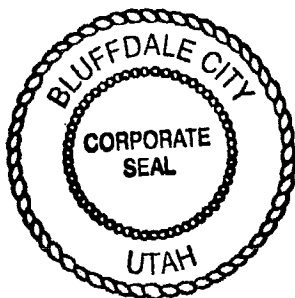
WHEREAS, the County possesses a fully functional correctional facility known as Oxbow, which could be utilized to enhance public safety by alleviating overcrowding at the Adult Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bluffdale unduly impacted by the inability to effectively incarcerate individuals arrested and transported by law enforcement officers and/or committed by competent judicial authority, and whom, if allowed to remain at large may commit new offenses and or prey upon the citizens within our jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Bluffdale hereby Resolves to seek relief from the inability to maintain individuals within the County Jail and seeks a commitment from all members of the Salt Lake County Council to open and maintain the Oxbow Jail for the benefit of all citizens within Salt Lake County.
