WHEREAS, In 1872 J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for the planting of trees, and

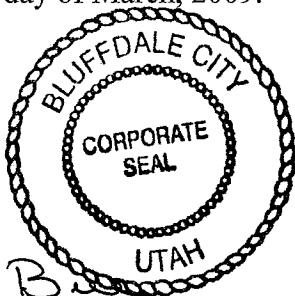
WHEREAS, this holiday called Arbor Day was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska, and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS THE CITY COUNCIL OF BLUFFDALE CITY, WE HEREBY PROCLAIM APRIL 22, 2009 AS ARBOR DAY IN BLUFFDALE, UTAH AND ENCOURAGE ALL RESIDENTS AND VISITORS TO BECOME ACTIVE IN PLANTING, PROMOTING, AND PRESERVING TREES WITHIN BLUFFDALE CITY.
