**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS MAYOR OF BLUFFDALE CITY, I HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 12, 2006 AS ARBOR DAY IN BLUFFDALE UTAH AND ENCOURAGE ALL RESIDENTS AND VISITORS TO BECOME ACTIVE IN THE PROMTING AND PRESERVATION OF TREES.**
