**BLUFFDALE CITY 2007 PRIMARY MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

The Bluffdale City Primary Municipal Election will be held on September 11, 2007. There are three (3) City Council seats up for election.

**Registration:** To vote in the election you must be a registered voter. Voters may register in person with the Salt Lake County Elections Office at 2001 South State Street, #S1100, in Salt Lake City. The deadline to register in person is 15 days before the election ( August 27, 2007). You can also, register by-mail. A by-mail voter registration form is available on the County Clerk's web-site at [www.clerk.slco.org](http://www.clerk.slco.org). Registration forms are also available at many locations such as the City Offices, post offices and libraries. The deadline to register by-mail is 30 days before the election (August 13, 2007).

**Absentee Voting:** Any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot. Applications are available at the Bluffdale City Fire Station - (Administrative Offices) 14350 South 2200 West. A registered voter may vote by absentee ballot in person at the Bluffdale City Fire Station (Administrative Offices) beginning (August 20, 2007) up until the Monday before the election (September 10, 2007) - Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

**Early Voting:** Early Voting differs from absentee voting in that voters may visit an early voting location during a 10 day period up to two weeks before the election and cast a vote in person without having to complete an absentee ballot application. In order to participate in early voting, **voters must be registered at least 30 days prior to the election and provide identification.** The early voting location will be at the Bluffdale City Fire Station - (Administrative Offices) 14350 South 2200 West, 14 days before the election (August 28, 2007 to September 7, 2007) - Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

**2007 Bluffdale City Polling Location:** The polling location for **all** voting precincts in Bluffdale City 3801, 3802, 3803, 3804, 3805, and 3806 will be the Midvalley Bible Church located at 13885 South 2700 West.

### COUNCIL CORNER

We are very disappointed and saddened by the decision of the Utah Supreme Court to grant Bluffdale Mountain Homes' petition for disconnection from Bluffdale City.

The Court has seen proper to deny to Bluffdale the right which state law grants to cities to guide their own destinies and manage their own growth. If carried forward to its logical conclusion, the precedent established by this decision will encourage developers to threaten or seek disconnection of land from any city simply because they do not like the land use principles embodied in the vision, plans and ordinances of that city. We believe that this empowerment of coercion and similar behaviors will ultimately lead to poor planning and mounting problems in Utah's Cities and Towns. We believe that some of the plans and proposals being empowered by this decision will lead to increased social and economic costs for Herriman and Bluffdale.

With the court case now behind us, we as a city council will endeavor to mitigate the effects of this land being developed with much greater density than would be allowed in Bluffdale. While we would have preferred to have some control of the development standards, it was clear that the developers were unwilling to compromise on this issue.

We will no doubt feel some negative effects from this decision, but will still be able to keep the traditional rural values of our wonderful community and not have to pay all economic costs associated with the higher density type of development.

We look forward to continuing to work to preserve the unique character Bluffdale is known for. It will just have to be smaller than we would have liked it to be.

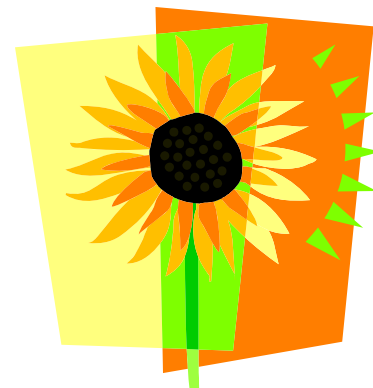
