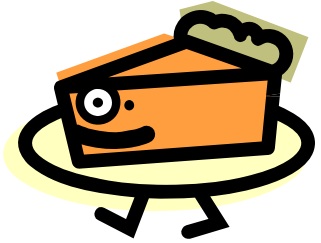

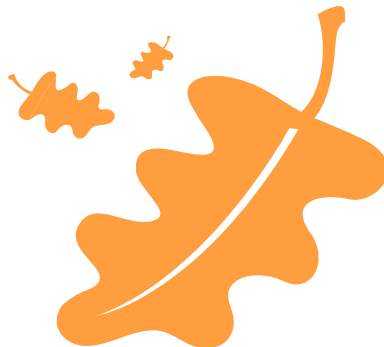
STREET PARKING
