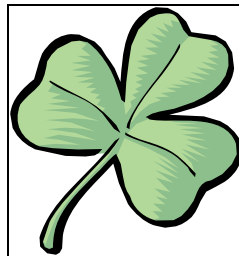

All signs in Bluffdale must be placed on private property with owner permission. This includes, yard sale, open house, realty, lemonade, and for sale type signs. There is a \$25 impound fee for each and every sign placed on public property. The impound cost can add up quickly depending on the number of signs placed around town. 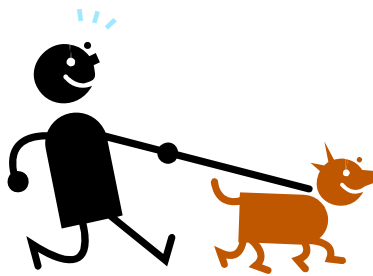
If you would rather vote on the electronic voting machines but would still like to avoid long lines, early voting is offered throughout the county two weeks before election day.
