It's time once again for the Bluffdale City Golf Tournament. So gather your teammates, your clubs and your prize winning swing and join us for a little friendly competition!

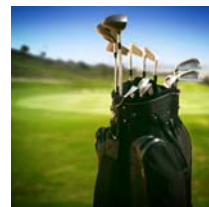
