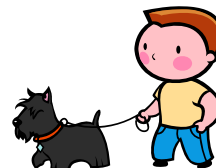

EARTHQUAKE PREPAREDNESS

FEMA and several state organizations have worked hard to put together an earthquake hazards and preparedness pamphlet titled *Putting Down Roots in Earthquake Country - Your Handbook for Earthquakes in Utah*.

The Pamphlet includes four sections: Why Should I Care?, Why Should I Prepare?, What Should I do? And What Else Should I Know?
