ATTENTION ALL DOG OWNERS

It's time to renew your dog licenses. All dog licenses must be renewed yearly and proof of rabies vaccination must be provided. Any dogs without a license after February 28, 2009 will be subject to late fees and/or a citation. It is the law to license your dog.

License Fees: Spayed/Neutered \$10 Unaltered \$15

A Rabies Clinic will be held at the Riverton Veterinary Hospital on 2789 West 12600 South on February 7, 2009 from 9 am to 1 pm. Bluffdale City staff will be on site to issue dog licenses as well.



SNOW REMOVAL

Clear you windows of snow and frost:

I am sure most of you have witnessed the haphazard motorist driving down the road peering through a small break in the frost or snow covering the windshield in winters past. As a safety reminder, it is illegal to operate a motor vehicle with the windshield or side passenger windows and rearview mirrors obstructed. (UCA41-6a-1635) You must clean snow completely off your windshield prior to driving. This includes frost. Please take the extra time to completely remove snow from all windows and allow your defroster to clear your windows of frost prior to driving.

Parking on streets during snow storms:

Residents must not park their vehicles or trailers on the roadway when it is snowing or when snow is on the ground between November 1st and April 1st. This law provides access for snow plows to clear snow from city streets during and following snow storms. City snowplows cannot safely plow streets when cars are parked on the roadway. Accidents between snowplows and illegally parked vehicles cost the city and in turn city residents unnecessary expense. - Captain Armand Glick

Snow Removal:

The Bluffdale City Public Works Department would also like to ask residents to not push snow from your property out into the city streets. This is counterproductive to our snow removal efforts and can cause our plow drivers to have to return to streets that have already been plowed instead of focusing on other areas.

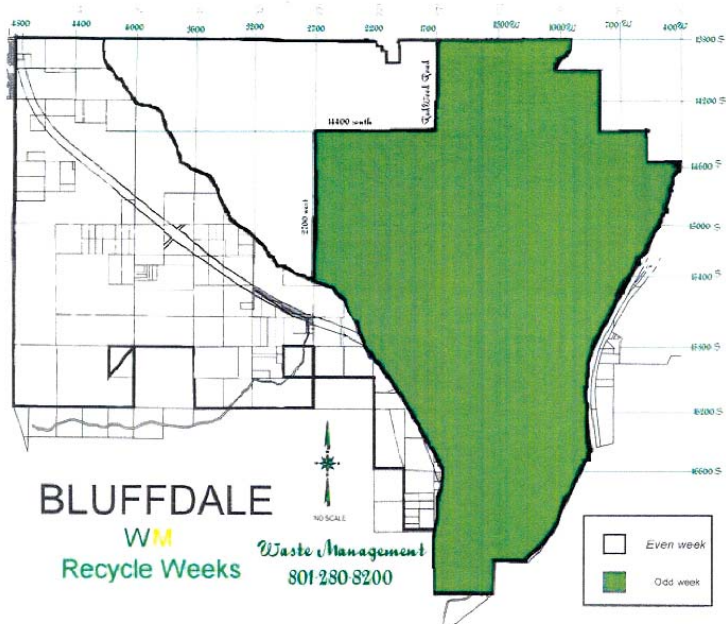
2009 HOLIDAY GARBAGE SCHEDULE
