NOTICE OF 2009 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

A municipal election will be held this fall to elect a Mayor and two City Council members. Candidates for Mayor and City Council seats are At Large and will serve four (4) year terms.

DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY

Begins: July 1, 2009 and Ends: July 15, 2009

Citizens desiring to run for office must file a "Declaration of Candidacy" with the Bluffdale City Recorder. The forms will be available in the office of the Bluffdale City Recorder beginning July 1, 2009. The filing period will run: **July 1, 2009 through July 15, 2009**, during regular City Hall hours: 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday - recorder's office is located at 14350 South 2200 West.

A candidate must have been a resident of Bluffdale City for at least 12 months (365 days) immediately prior to the date of the election (November 3, 2009). All candidates must be a current registered voter.

BACKFLOW PREVENTION

Protect your family, neighbors and community from contaminated water; it is your responsibility:

The Bluffdale City Water Department would like to remind everyone..."Utah Code, Section 19-4-112 (2d) states, "there shall be no cross connection between the potable (drinking water system) and non-potable (auxiliary water supply) systems."

What this means is if you have a sprinkler system that uses secondary water (pressurized or gravity fed) you cannot directly connect it to your culinary (potable or drinkable water) sprinkler system. If the two sources are connected to the sprinkler system there is a chance that the secondary water will be able to get into the culinary system and no one wants to drink Utah Lake Water.

There are safe & legal ways to set up a sprinkler system so either water source can be used, but not at the same time. Connecting both sources requires a physical disconnect and an approved RPZ (Reduced Pressure Zone Assembly).
