SOUTHWEST AQUEDUCT CONSTRUCTION UPDTAE

The Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District will complete construction of the first segment of Southwest Aqueduct in Bluffdale City. The Southwest Aqueduct is a new 66-inch diameter steel pipeline that will allow the District to provide drinking water to meet the future needs of Bluffdale City as well as the majority of the western portion of Salt Lake County. Pipeline construction began last December near the intersection of 14400 South and 3200 West. The final segment of pipe will be placed across the intersection of 14400 South and 3200 West beginning the week of March 9, 2009.

Bluffdale City is working closely with the District's general contractor, Allied Construction, to minimize impacts to the public during construction. Construction in the intersection is anticipated to last approximately two weeks. During this period, a two lane detour will be provided around the construction zone to keep east west traffic open. **The access to 14400 South from 3200 West will be closed during this two week period.** An automated message board will be provided, and that clear detour routes be established throughout construction. Despite best efforts to maintain smooth traffic control around the construction zone, delays are to be expected and alternative routes should be considered if possible during construction.

- 12:00 noon **Alternative Heating/Cooking Sources** - Nancy Middleton

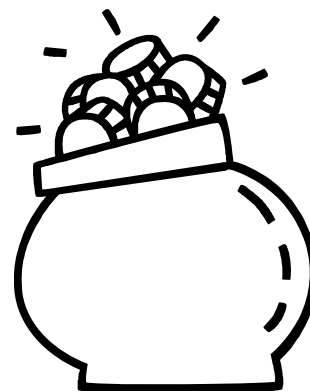
Mini-classes offered each hour between 10:00 am and 1:00pm:
