### CAMP WILLIAMS MUNITION CLEAN-UP

The Utah National Guard (UTNG) is launching an effort to investigate if old munitions may be present on lands that were once used for training at Camp Williams. These areas may now be located just outside the current installation boundary. Six areas are being investigated in conjunction with this effort, including one area located near Bluffdale. The 78-acre site is located along the north-eastern border of the installation, near Beef Hollow.

In conjunction with the start of this project, the UTNG will host an informational open house to inform local residents about the upcoming investigation and cleanup. The open house will be held October 22, 2009 from 6 to 8 p.m. at Fort Herriman Middle School located at 14058 Mirabella Drive, in Herriman.
