Do you know someone looking for a temporary job? The US census Bureau is looking to hire more than 1,000 Census Takers in Salt Lake County for the 2010 population survey. The jobs are temporary, part-time work and will pay \$14 an hour.

Census takers will offer professional assistance to individuals who do not complete and return their census form by mail.

Salt Lake County residents interested in applying for census jobs should call the Salt Lake Census Office at 801.736.5060 to schedule a time and location to take a 30-minute multiple-choice test that measures the skills required for census employment.
