

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-06

A RESOLUTION BY THE BLUFFDALE CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE SOUTH VALLEY SEWER DISTRICT'S PLAN TO CONSTRUCT A WASTE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY TO INCREASE WASTE WATER TREATMENT CAPACITY AMONG MEMBER CITIES IN SOUTHERN SALT LAKE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the South Valley Sewer District (District) has reached its capacity limit with the South Valley Water Reclamation Facility (SVWRF); and

WHEREAS, Bluffdale is a member city in the District and is currently experiencing considerable growth and is expected to experience significant growth in the future; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to construct, and is seeking regulatory approval to construct, a new waste water treatment facility located in the city of Riverton to add capacity for members of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bluffdale City, Utah:

- 1 It supports the District's efforts to obtain regulatory approval with the City of Riverton to construct the waste water facility.
