WHEREAS, Bluffdale City desires to promote the importance of trees for the benefits they provide for its citizens; and

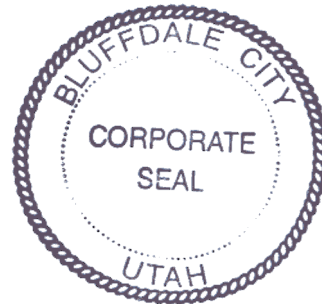
