



Bluffdale OWD Rodeo Queen Attendant Requirements and Responsibilities

Before competing in the contest, you must read and understand the following and sign at the bottom.

AFTER WINNING A CROWN FROM THE OLD WEST DAYS RODEO QUEEN CONTEST:

- ❖ Contestants cannot have ever been married or pregnant. If at any time during the year you get married or become pregnant, your crown will be handed down to the Attendant under you.
- ❖ During the 2023 Bluffdale OWD Rodeo you must be willing to help and participate in: Presentation Rides, pushing cows, carrying flags and anything else you may be needed for.
- ❖ When attending the rodeo or required events, you must dress the part. Example: When you are at the rodeo grounds you must stay in your western attire including your crown, buckle, and banner.
- ❖ Please keep in mind that you represent the Bluffdale OWD Rodeo, and everyone involved, for the entire year. Be kind, be appropriate in speech and the way you conduct yourself at all times. Everything you do reflects on the Rodeo Committee and Bluffdale City.
- ❖ You agree to attend a photo shoot. You agree to allow any and all photos to be used as promotional material for Bluffdale OWD Rodeo and as needed for Bluffdale City use.
- ❖ You must be willing to attend the 2023 Bluffdale OWD Rodeo and other city events including the City Celebration at Day Ranch Park on August 12, 2023.
- ❖ You must attend and represent “Bluffdale OWD Rodeo Royalty” in at least one outside rodeo and/or parade of the Royalties choosing. All appearances must be approved through the Rodeo Queen Coordinator.
- ❖ If at any time during the season you are found to be disrespectful in any way to the Bluffdale OWD Events Board, Committee, Royalty, or Bluffdale City staff, you will be asked to resign and your crown, buckle, sash, and any other awards will be passed down to the Royalty next in line.
- ❖ Queen must be willing to attend the next Bluffdale OWD Rodeo Queen Contest to help welcome the new Royalty and to give up your crown.
- ❖ You agree that the horse you compete on will be the horse you use at events. Any change in horse must be approved by the Rodeo Queen coordinator.
- ❖ You and your horse must always be well groomed. Your horse must show good care and good health and you must remember this at all events.
- ❖ You and your affiliates should always remember that even when not in official attire, you are in the public eye. This means no swearing, smoking, chewing tobacco, illegal drug use, or drinking alcoholic beverages.
- ❖ You should always remember to handle yourself as a horsewoman. All training and discipline should be done at home.
- ❖ You are responsible for your own transportation to and from all Rodeo Royalty appearances.
- ❖ If you are a minor, you should be supervised by a chaperon or parent at all times.
- ❖ You agree to the following Term and Conditions: The City of Bluffdale (the “City”) reserves the right to accept or reject any registration in its sole discretion. I, for myself and on behalf of my executors, minors, administrators, heirs, successors and/or assigns, hereby forever waive, release and discharge, and further,

do hereby agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City and the sponsors, coordinating groups and any individual associated with the City, including persons or entities associated with Bluffdale City from and against any and all claims of liability of any kind or nature whatsoever, including without limitation, death, personal injury, contraction of a virus or disease, lost, stolen or damaged property, or otherwise, which claims arise out of or are related to my participation in City events. I agree to abide by all rules & guidelines, including but not limited to the rules stated on registration forms and the City's websites, as the same may be amended by the City at any time in its sole discretion, and understand that failure to abide by any rules & guidelines could lead to immediate removal from my participation in City events, in the City's sole discretion. I hereby grant full permission to use my name and any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recordings, or other record of City events for any purpose. Finally, I understand that my participation in City activities could be potentially hazardous to me, and that I should not enter and participate unless I am physically able. I recognize that there are potential risks associated with my involvement in City events, and I have the responsibility and obligation to determine the potential risks associated with the activities I participate in, including but not limited to, accidents, contact with other participants, effects of weather and conditions of the road, and so forth, and I agree to fully assume such risks. I understand I am solely responsible for my own safety while traveling to and from or participating in any event. In signing this form, I acknowledge I have read and fully understand my own liability and do accept the risks and restrictions as a condition to my participation in the City events. Minors will be accepted with a parent's signature.

I _____ have read and understand the obligation above. If for any reason I cannot uphold my duties to the Crown, whether I am the Queen or an Attendant, that my position, awards, and royalties will be passed down to the Royalty next in line.
